Prof. em. Dr. DDr. h.c. Christian Körner is professor of Botany at University of Basel, Switzerland. He has a Ph.D. from the University of Innsbruck on water relations of alpine plants. He is currently involved in several research projects, among these are: “Effects of elevated CO₂-concentration on plants and ecosystems”, “The Swiss Canopy Crane Project”, “Alpine plant ecology” and “High Elevation Treeline Research”. He is, furthermore, president of the Alpine Research Station ALPFOR on the Furkapass. He is a member of the German National Academy of Sciences Leopoldina, the Austrian Academy of Sciences, and an honorary member of the Ecological Society of America. He was ERC Advanced Grant holder (2009-2014) - TREELIM, exploring thermal tree species limits in Europe.
